Gagou – belongs to a South Africa language – "Doing good/well" or "I love you", that is here name!





The Outremer was plan and design by Gérard Danson and bouild by the Outremer shipyard in La Grande Motte/ France.

This model benefits from extended transom and the famous large roof version which is the same as the Outremer 45. Unbelievable result! Large accommodation under the roof, no need to climb from the cockpit to the hull, all could be done under the roof on each side.

In any case, the most important is conserved, performance appear as evidence: Light boat, dagger-boards, slim hull and tillers ... the sum up of Outremer boats!

This 43 is the last ever produced by Outremer No. 33, she has been accommodating in 4 cabins version + owner bathroom and technical area.

Very well equipped, she is in a very good condition!
